

WONDER GOD

Acts 17:16-34

God's heart

While Paul was waiting for them in Athens, he was **greatly distressed** to see that the city was full of idols. So he reasoned in the synagogue with both Jews and God-fearing Greeks, as well as in the marketplace **day by day** with those who happened to be there. Acts 17:16-17

The Truth about the God of Wonders

For as I walked around and looked carefully at your objects of worship, I even found an altar with this inscription: TO AN UNKNOWN GOD. So you are ignorant of the very thing you worship—and this is what I am going to proclaim to you. Acts 17:23

1. God is the _____
"The God who made the world and everything in it is the Lord of heaven and earth and does not live in temples built by human hands." Acts 17:24

The Son is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For in him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through him and for him. Colossians 1:15-16

2. God is the _____
"And he is not served by human hands, as if he needed anything. Rather, he himself gives everyone life and breath and everything else." Acts 17:25

*And my God will meet **all your needs** according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:19*

3. God is the _____
"From one man he made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and he marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands." Acts 17:26

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8

The Truth about the God of Wonders (continued)

4. God is the _____
"For in him we live and move and have our being.' As some of your own poets have said, 'We are his offspring.'" Acts 17:28

He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. Col. 1:17

Surely God is my help; the Lord is the one who sustains me. Psalm 54:4

5. God is the _____
"In the past God overlooked such ignorance, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent." Acts 17:30

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9

Out of his fullness we have all received grace in place of grace already given. John 1:16

6. God is the _____
"For he has set a day when he will judge the world with justice by the man he has appointed. He has given proof of this to everyone by raising him from the dead." Acts 17:31

For we will all stand before God's judgment seat. It is written: "'As surely as I live,' says the Lord, 'every knee will bow before me; every tongue will acknowledge God.'" So then, each of us will give an account of ourselves to God. Romans 14:10b-12

Our response to Jesus

*When they heard Paul speak about the resurrection of the dead, some laughed in contempt, but others said, "We want to hear more about this later." That ended Paul's discussion with them, **but some joined him and became believers...** Acts 17:32-34 (NLT)*
