Joshua 2

The paradox of the promised life

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. Hebrews 11:1

- *Humble yourself to be honored.* James 4:10
- *When you are weak, you are strong.* 2 Corinthians 12:10

Rahab's walk of faith

So they went and entered the house of a prostitute named Rahab and stayed there. Joshua 2:1b

Believe

"...the LORD your God is God in heaven above and on the earth below."
Joshua 2:11

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. Hebrews 11:6

Make a commitment

"Our lives for your lives!" the men assured her. "If you don't tell what we are doing, we will treat you kindly and faithfully when the LORD gives us the land." Joshua 2:14

Follow through

So she let them down by a rope through the window...Now the men had said to her, "This oath you made us swear will not be binding on us unless, when we enter the land, you have tied this scarlet cord in the window through which you let us down, and unless you have brought your...family into your house." Joshua 2:15,17-18

The pain of faith

"Agreed," she replied. "Let it be as you say." So she sent them away, and they departed. And she tied the scarlet cord in the window. Joshua 2:21

The gifts of faith in action

• Life

By faith the prostitute Rahab, because she welcomed the spies, was not killed with those who were disobedient. Hebrews 11:31

*Then they burned the whole city and everything in it... But Joshua spared Rahab the prostitute, with her family and all who belonged to her, because she hid the men Joshua had sent as spies to Jericho—and **she lives** among the Israelites to this day. Joshua 6:24-25*

• Redemption

*"...was not even Rahab the prostitute considered **righteous** for what she did..? James 2:25*

Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you." Matthew 17:20
