God's promised protection

What God is doing

Why do the nations conspire and the peoples plot in vain? ...The One enthroned in heaven laughs... "I have installed my king on Zion, my holy mountain." Psalm 2:1-6

conspire + plot in vain = rebellion without chance of success

Habakkuk's questions

How long, LORD, must I call for help, but you do not listen? Or cry out to you, "Violence!" but you do not save? Why do you make me look at injustice? Why do you tolerate wrongdoing? Habakkuk 1:1-3

Where are you? What are you doing?
How long must I call for help?
Why does the enemy seem to have the upper hand?

God's answers

"Look at the nations and watch—and be utterly amazed. For I am going to do something in your days that you would not believe, even if you were told.
Habakkuk 2:5

- Believe: I will turn things around. Victory will come. When I am finished - the enemy will no longer have the upper hand.

"For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea." Habakkuk 2:14

God's answers, Continued...

- Remember: Write the revelation down for a future generation
"For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it linger, wait for it; it will certainly come..." Habakkuk 2:3
- Live: To stay alive, be reserved, to flourish, to enjoy life, be animated, to live in happiness, to breathe.

*"The righteous person will **live** by his faithfulness." Habakkuk 2:4*
