God's strategic plan to rescue our hearts

They should be rich in good works and **generous** to those in need, always being **ready to share** with others. 1 Timothy 6:17-18

Mitigate risk

...not to be proud...

Rich people may think they are wise... Proverbs 28:11

If you give special attention and a good seat to the rich person, but you say to the poor one, "You can stand over there, or else sit on the floor"—well, doesn't this discrimination show that your judgments are guided by evil motives? James 2:3,4

Destroys our relationship with others

...not to trust in their money, which is so unreliable...
