GAME CHANGERS

TAKING STEPS THAT CAN TRANSFORM YOUR LIFE

It's a Game Changer

² One evening David got up from his bed and walked around on the roof of the palace. From the roof he saw a woman bathing. The woman was very beautiful,³ and David sent someone to find out about her. The man said, "She is Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam and the wife (Uriah) the Hittite."⁴ Then David sent messengers to get her. She came to him, and he slept with her. (Now she was purifying herself from her monthly uncleanness.) Then she went back home.

⁵ The woman conceived and sent word to David, saying, "I am pregnant."⁶ So David sent this word to Joab: "Send me Uriah the Hittite." And Joab sent him to David.⁷ When Uriah came to him, David asked him how Joab was, how the soldiers were and how the war was going.⁸ Then David said to Uriah, "Go down to your house and wash your feet." So Uriah left the palace, and a gift from the king was sent after him.⁹ But Uriah slept at the entrance to the palace with all his master's servants and did not go down to his house. 2 Samuel 11:1-9

¹⁴ In the morning David wrote a letter to Joab and sent it with Uriah.¹⁵ In it he wrote, "Put Uriah out in front where the fighting is fiercest. Then withdraw from him so he will be struck down and die." 2 Samuel 11:14-15

²⁷ After the time of mourning was over, David had her brought to his house, and she became his wife and bore him a son. But the thing David had done displeased the Lord. 2 Samuel 11:27

The Lord sent Nathan to David. When he came to him, he said, "There were two men in a certain town, one rich and the other poor.² The rich man had a very large number of sheep and cattle,³ but the poor man had nothing except one little ewe lamb he had bought. He raised it, and it grew up with him and his children. It shared his food, drank from his cup and even slept in his arms. It was like a daughter to him.⁴ "Now a traveler came to the rich man, but the rich man refrained from taking one of his own sheep or cattle to prepare a meal for the traveler who had come to him. Instead, he took the ewe lamb that belonged to the poor man and prepared it for the one who had come to him."⁵ David burned with anger against the man and said to Nathan, "As surely as the Lord lives, the man who did this must die!⁶ He must pay for that lamb four times over, because he did such a thing and had no pity."⁷ Then Nathan said to David, "You are the man! 2 Samuel 12:1-7
